

All ladies are welcome to join in the Women's Bible Study on Thursday, March 15th at 10:00am at Tudors on Rt. 60 in St. Albans.




We will be providing a meal for the Rock Ministries on March 11th.



Bonhoeffer. If you would like a copy of the book, please let Mike Kutz know.


We will be studying this book ahead of the release of the movie "Bonhoeffer" in November.
